Our Bible story for this session shows us that Jesus doesn't just point out a good way to go: he said that he WAS the way.

Our Bible story for this session is in the Gospel of **John 14:1-7**

Bible Story

Jesus was talking to his disciples at the last supper. His disciples were really worried because Jesus was saying about going away which was confusing them. Jesus comforted them and said that was going to prepare a place for them in heaven. Thomas, one of the disciples, said that they did not know where he was going, so how would they know

where to go to follow him? Jesus replied that he was the way, the truth and the life, that he would guide them to heaven and that if they knew him then they would know his Father (God) too. The disciples still asked him lots of questions. Philip, another one of the disciples, asked Jesus to show them the Father; Jesus said he (Jesus) was the same as the Father.

In this bible reading Jesus is saying that he is a guide. When we go on a long journey, we take a map or a SATNAV these are our guides of how to get somewhere. Jesus is our guide to get closer to God and get to heaven. This is what he meant when he said that he was the way. Jesus shows us some of the dangers too and things that may harm us.
